Madam/Sir,

As you are aware, CBSE has amended its Academic Assessment and Practices for classes IX to XII to align assessment to Competency Based Education. Accordingly, modalities worked out for other classes in KVS and the same may be followed for the session 2022-23. The detail modalities and norms are given hereunder:

Further, the following general guidelines on Assessment and Promotion Policy for classes III to IX and XI may be noted for the smooth conduct of assessment for the session 2022-23.

For Primary Classes (III-V) :-

- 1. As cited in the table above, Periodical test / Midterm test/Annual Examination need to be conducted following the blue print and weightage adopted earlier focusing on the competencies meant for each subject.
- 2. No detention Policy as per RTE will continue to be followed for classes I to VIII
- 3. Multi-disciplinary Projects (MDP) for classes III to VIII will continue to assess the Creative skills and performance of the students. Only one MDP is to be awarded per term for all subjects.

For Middle Classes :- (VI -VIII):-

- 1. At least 30% Competency based questions (CCT skill questions) should be part of all kinds pen paper test.
- 2. For Term-II syllabus for classes VI –VIII, 10%, 20% and 30% syllabus of the I –Term will be included for classes VI-VIII respectively as per KVS letter dated 05.06.2018. The Deputy Commissioner of the respective region will intimate 10 %, 20% and 30% syllabus of the Term-1 for each subject of classes VI-VIII to the students/teachers in advance.
- 3. Multi-disciplinary Projects (MDP) for classes III to VIII will continue to assess the Creative skills and performance of the students. Only one MDP is to awarded per term per for all subjects.
- 4. No detention policy as per RTE will be followed up to class VIII.

For Secondary Classes :- (IX- X)

- 1. CBSE Circular No. CBSE/dir(ACAD)/2022/ dated 20-05-2022, Circular No.ACAD-57/2022 on Assessment and Evaluation Practices of the Board for the session 2022-23 need to be strictly followed.
- 2. The qualifying marks for class IX students in each subject shall be 33% in each subject. This implies that the student is expected to score 33% including both Theory component (80) and Internal Assessment (20). However, overall 33% marks is required to promote the students in the next higher class.
- 3. For class IX students offering 5 subjects and failing in two of the five subjects shall be placed in compartment in those subjects. And if any student failing in more than 02 subjects shall be treated as **'Essential repeat'**

For Senior Secondary Classes: - (XI-XII)

- 1. CBSE Circular No. CBSE/dir(ACAD)/2022/ dated 20-05-2022, Circular No.ACAD-57/2022 on Assessment and Evaluation Practices of the Board for the session 2022-23 need to be strictly followed.
- 2. The qualifying marks for class XI students in each subject for promotion shall be 33% in each subject. It is to further clarify that in a subject where practical components are involved; separate pass (33%) is required in Theory component and Practical component respectively. This implies that students need to score 33% out of 70 (Theory) and 33% out of 30 marks in Practical separately. Similarly, Students need to secure separate pass (33%) Theory component (33% out of 80) and Internal Assessment (33% out of 20) for subjects having Internal Assessment. The overall 33% marks are also required for the promotion of the students in next higher class.
- 3. Students failing in one of the five subjects in Class XI will be placed under Compartment in that subject and students failing in more than one subject will be treated as **Essential Repeat'**.
- 4. Supplementary Examination in the pattern of Annual Examination for classes IX and XI will be conducted 3 weeks after declaration of results (May be in the **Third week of April 2023)** by the Regional Office concerned.
- 5. Students need to secure 33% in the supplementary examination (Theory only) to get qualify for the next higher class.

6. Wherever applicable, for the promotion of students of IX and XI, the participation in sports at different levels, as per KVS guidelines, need to be considered and the prescribed weightage as per F.No.110355/01/2019-20/KVS(HQ)/Sports/BOG/480 / dated 21.05.2020 should be added to promote the student in the respective subject. This provision should not be used to bring the student to the zone of Compartment.

General Instructions:-

- 1. Promotion Committee is to be constituted as per KVS guidelines to finalize the results of classes IX and XI with Principal as the Chairman of the Committee and members as decided by the Principal.
- 2. Co-Scholastic activities for classes III to IX and XI are to be carried out and assessed by TGT(WET), TGT(AE) and TGT(P&HE) and other teachers who are involved on Three point/Six point /Nine point scale as per the guidelines and relevantrecords are to be maintained by them.
- 3. For assessment of AI, guidelines issued by KVS need to be followed.
- 4. The date of declaration of results for Academic Year 2022-23 is 28th March 2023 (Tuesday).
- 5. For the Assessment of Classes X and XII, CBSE Circular No. CBSE/dir (ACAD)/2022/ dated 20-05-2022, Circular No.ACAD-57/2022 on Assessment and Evaluation Practices of the Board for the session 2022-23 need to be strictly followed.
- 6. Students of classes I to X will do at least one Art-Integrated Project work in each subject as part of Subject Enrichment Activity which should be of trans-disciplinary nature. For more details, CBSE circular CBSE/Dir(Acad)/2020/ dated 14th May 2020, Circular No; Acad 33/2020 may be referred to.
